PUBLIC SECTION

1. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

4. MINUTES

5. MATTERS ARISING

-Cllr Johnson confirmed she had not received any further information concerning the vehicles being parked on the corner of Herringfleet Road. However the vehicle that looks like it has been abandoned as it has been left in the layby for several months, the road taxis due to run out tomorrow . It was agreed Cllr Bosworth will notify the Clerk if the car is left untaxed as the DVLA will need to be notified.

-The Clerk reported she had received notification from NCC Highways Dept concerning the 2020/21 Parish Partnership Scheme. It was agreed this will be on the agenda at the next meeting for further discussion.

7. PLANNING

It was felt that concerns/objections submitted by both the Parish Council and local residents had not been taken into consideration.

After some discussion it was agreed to send a letter to the senior planning officer outlining some of the conditions that the Parish Council feels must be included in the consent. Cllr Nunn will forward a draft of this letter onto the Clerk after the meeting.

It was agreed, after receiving the formal notification from GYBC, to write a letter of thanks to the Broads Authority as they too objected to the Caldecott Hall application and have asked to be kept informed on the outcome.
